Anchal College, Padampur accredited with B+ (3rd Cycle) by NAAC is a premier educational institution of Odisha established in 1965. This institution stands as a lamp post within a radius of 80 kms and imparts undergraduate teaching in Arts, Science and Commerce. - 6. APA style should be followed for referencing and citation.
- 7. The decision of the organizing committee will be final and binding in all respects.



Nrusinghanath Temple



Nrusinghanath is a famous visiting place of the district which belongs to the Padampur Sub-division. It is only 27 kms far from Padampur. The temple of Sri Sri Nrusinghanath is situated at the bottom of the Gandhamardan Mountain which is approximately 3234 feet high. There is historical evidence that the Buddhist Shramana Nagarjuna lived here in the past. There flows a fountain near the temple which takes different names at different places in its course such as Kapil Dhar, Bhim Dhar, Chal Dhar, Sita Kund & Go Kund.

Harishankar Temple

Sri Sri Harisankar Devasthana is a temple on the slopes of Gandhamardhan hills, Bolangir District of Odisha in India. It is 40 km away from Padampur. It is popular for its scenes of nature and connection to two Hindu lords, Vishnu and Shiva. As a holy place, along with a stream passing on the granite bed, it has given some visitors a feeling of peace. On the opposite side of the Gandhamardhan hills is the temple of Nrusinghanath. The plateau between the two temples has been found to have ancient Buddhist ruins, which are considered to be remnants of the ancient Parimalgiri University.



Devdarha Waterfall



Devdarha waterfall is a popular tourist place located at the Border of Odisha and Chhattisgarh, and it is about 18km from Padampur. The waterfalls flow through large rocks that attract tourists. It is a beautiful place in the Bargarh district to visit with family and friends and weekend picnic. Winter season is a great time to visit Devdarha waterfall.

Jageswar Temple & Patora Dam

Lord Shiva is the presiding deity of Jageswar Temple. It is very amazing to see the artwork of this Jogeswar Mandir. The upper part of the temple is made up of 3 large Shiva linga shapes. A huge Lord Hanuman idol is at the entrance of the temple, and in addition, other gods are worshipped in this Yogeswar temple. Baba Jogeswar Mandir is one of the most famous temples in the Nuapada District. Patora Dam site of the Upper Jonk Irrigation Project is situated at a distance of 20 km from Nuapada Town. The sunrise and sunset at this dam are pleasant for the tourists. Patora Reservoir is Attracts tourists to come here in winter for a beautiful natural environment.
